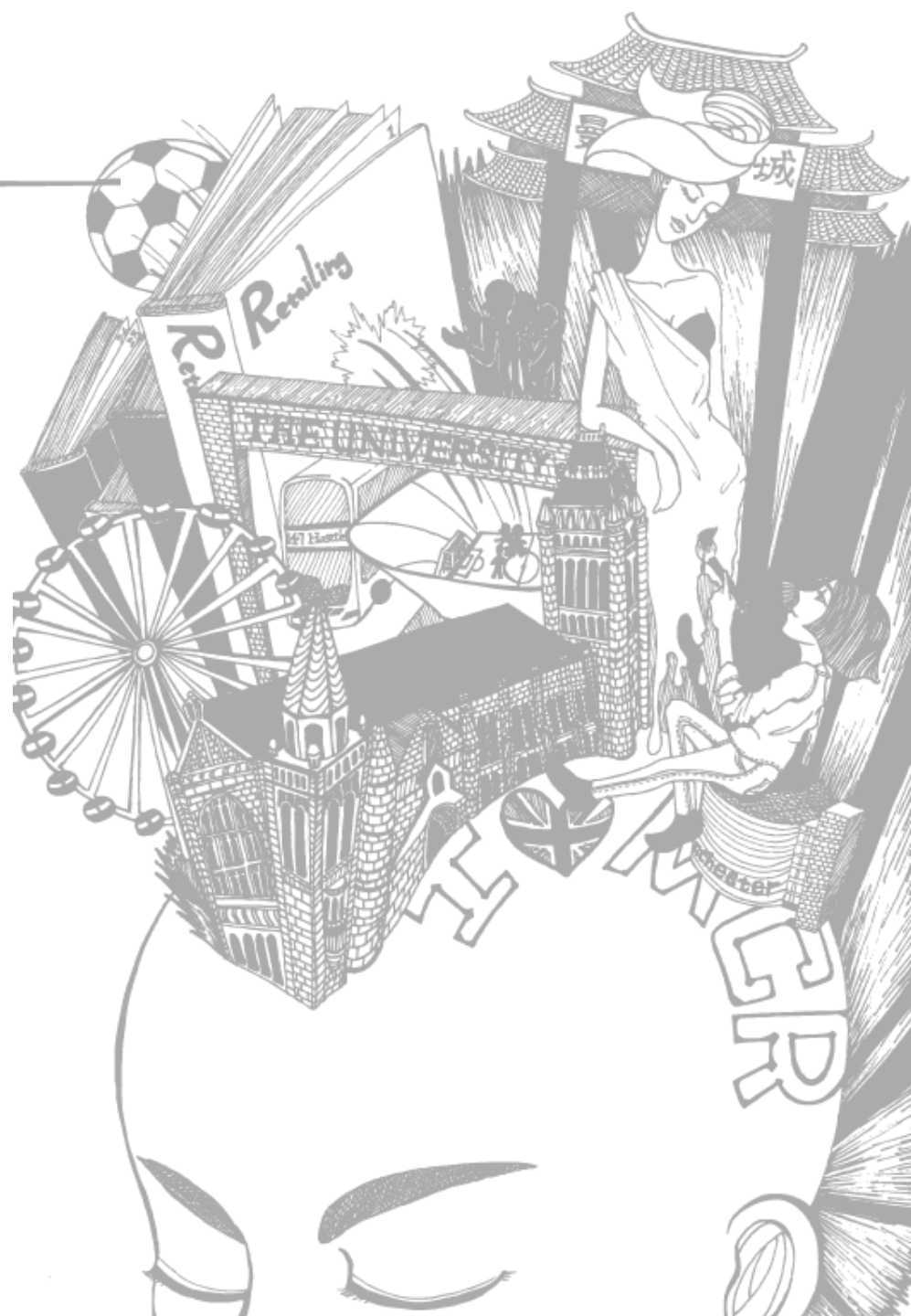

**7 ADJUST** your strategy

## Objective

The main aim of our study was to establish the prevalence of social networking accounts among a group of second-level students (aged 15–18 years), to determine whether they used privacy settings, and to examine their attitudes to various aspects of social media use in medicine.

## Design

A descriptive study design was employed. The questionnaire was constructed specifically to address the attitudes of students to social media. No similar suitable validated questionnaire could be identified. The questionnaire consisted of 20 questions with a mixture of open answer, yes/no, and Likert scale response options.
