Apartments

Hotels

Best Western Willow Bank Hotel (from £74 per night)

This ideally located hotel on the outskirts of Manchester city centre is just minutes from the universities, main conference arenas and entertainment areas of the city. The Willow Bank Hotel is close to Manchester International Airport and provides easy access to Old Trafford and the Trafford Centre.

Chancellors Hotel (from £40 per night when booked online)

This is a 3 star AA rated hotel with excellent transport links to all key Manchester shops and attractions. The 70 ensuite bedrooms feature flat screen television, hair dryer, telephone, and complimentary tea and coffee. Chancellors also offers FREE high speed broadband and FREE WiFi in public areas.

Pendulum Hotel (from £82 per night)

Enjoy the contemporary atmosphere at the Pendulum Hotel, where value, comfort and a prime urban location are included. Conveniently located just 10 minutes away from Piccadilly Station.

Deansgate Locks Premier Inn (from £29 per night on saver option, average price £61 per night)

Situated close to Old Trafford and just a short walk to main attractions and transport, the Hotel is ideally positioned next to the free 7 day city centre shuttle bus service and is one of few hotels in the city offering free on-site parking.

Holiday Inn Express Hotel Manchester (from £87 per night)

The hotel is situated on Oxford Road and is a 5-10 minute walk away from Manchester Metropolitan University and University of Manchester. Each room is fully equipped to include air conditioning, high speed internet & wireless access, an invigorating power shower, flat screen television with satellite channels and tea and coffee making facilities.

Hotel ibis Manchester Centre Portland Street (from £62 per night)

ibis Manchester Centre Portland Street is located in the centre of Manchester, close to all major attractions, as well as the shopping areas, nightlife and Old Trafford. Piccadilly and Oxford Road stations are just a few minutes from the hotel. Reduced parking rates available at Q-Park 75 St James Street, M1 4LX at the rear of the hotel.

Ibis Manchester City Princess Street (from £52 per night)

Ibis Manchester Centre Princess Street is a budget hotel. Book the hotel for a location less than 1 km from the city centre, close to the shopping and nightlife of central Manchester. Each of the hotel's 126 contemporary guest rooms comes with free wireless internet access and satellite TV. The café has hot and cold snacks 24 hours a day, and the friendly bar has a wide range of drinks. Manchester Oxford Road train station is 500m from the hotel.

Manchester Central Premier Inn (from £39 per night when you select the Saver Rate)

Conveniently located in the heart of Manchester city centre, opposite Manchester Central Convention Complex (formerly Gmex) and within walking distance of Bridgewater Hall, Town Hall, Oxford St, Deansgate and city centre shops bars and restaurants.

Portland Street Premier Inn (from £39 per night when you select the Saver Rate)

Ideally situated in the heart of Manchester, Piccadilly train station is just a 10 minute walk and there are tram links to Manchester Old Trafford stadium. Attractions nearby include Canal Street, Palace and Opera House theatres and lots of bars and restaurants. Gym facilities are also available nearby at a discounted rate for hotel guests. (£4 per visit, please ask at reception) Parking is available at a discounted rate (approx £13.50 per 24hrs) at the Q Park on St James St - M1 4LX. Voucher is available from hotel reception upon departure.

Travelodge Manchester Piccadilly (from £36 when you select the Saver rate)

Situated a convenient half a mile from Manchester Piccadilly railway station, the new look rooms in the brand new Manchester Piccadilly Hotel are the height of comfort and style. Parking is available nearby at NCP Parking, The Grand, Chatham Street, M1 3AY. Guests can obtain a discounted NCP parking ticket from the hotel reception on departure for this car park, this will reduce the cost of parking by 15%.

Travelodge Manchester Upper Brook Street (from £31 when you select the Saver rate)

The hotel is situated opposite the Manchester Royal Infirmary and therefore very close to the University of Manchester. Travelodge has chargeable car parking, available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Budget Accommodation

Hatters Hostels (from £13 per night for shared or £21 per night for private rooms)

The Hatters hostels are widely used by visiting students and are located close to UoM, MMU and main transport links.

Hotel ibis Budget, Manchester Centre, Pollard Street (from £38 per night)

Ibis budget Manchester Pollard Street is ideally located a stone's throw away from the city centre and a 10 minute walk from Piccadilly Station. The hotel has 150 en-suite shower "Cocoon" rooms for up to 3 people, air conditioning and flat screen TV with Freeview channels. Free WIFI throughout. 24/7 Reception. 24/7 snacks/drinks. Good value all you can eat breakfast. No on-site car-park. 100% non-smoking. All at an affordable price.

Student Accommodation

Manchester Student Homes (various prices)

Manchester Student Homes is affiliated with the University of Manchester, Manchester Metropolitan University and Salford University and is the Universities official source of student accommodation in the private sector. Website has a section devoted to short-term lets.

Manchester Rentahome (various prices)

Luxury and professional homes to let in Fallowfield, Withington, Didsbury, Chorlton, Victoria Park and Sale. Although short-term lets are not usually offered, if you are interested in a house share then please contact Manchester Rentahome around the beginning of September with the dates you are on campus and they will see if any short-term house-sharing opportunities are available.

Montgomery House (£80 per week)

If you are looking for student accommodation in Manchester which is great value affordable housing with all inclusive bills and internet costs then a room at Monty Halls could be your new home. Weston Court (£93 per week)

Weston Court has a stylish mix of 2, 3 and 4 bedroom apartments at £93 per week.
