
# 6 July 2016

- Memorandum of Understanding signed between the University of Manchester, Manchester Metropolitan University and the Royal College of Pathologists.
- Represents a partnership for the provision of the Life Sciences theme within the Doctor of Clinical Science (DClinSci) programmes as part of the Higher Specialist Scientist Training Programme (HSST).

## FRCPath/DClinSci/ICS

- MAHSE partner Universities will accept a pass in the FRCPath Part 1 examination in a relevant specialty in place of the Professional Doctorate (DClinSci) Section B.
- The Royal College of Pathologists will accept the research component of the Professional Doctorate (DClinSci) in a relevant specialty as the written option for the FRCPath Part 2.
- The NSHCS has clarified that the trainees can utilise elements from FRCPath Part 2 and/or the DClinSci Section C as the basis of their ICS Project report.


## FRCPath and DClinSci



### **FRCPath examinations**

- Two sessions a year Spring and Autumn
- Applications period
  - December to beginning of January (Spring session)
  - June to beginning of July (Autumn session)
- FRCPath Part 1: March and September (all on same day)
- FRCPath Part 2: March April or September November (depends on the specialty)




Reproductive Science: FRCPath Part 1 practical moved into FRCPath Part 2 from Autumn 2017.
